**Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at 2:30 PM**

As per the circular dated 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2025, meeting of the IQAC members is held in the Conference Hall, Main Building of the Institute, on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at 2:30 pm.

Prof. I. P. Gowramma, Convenor, IQAC, RIE Mysuru, welcomed the members to the meeting. Prof. Pratyusha Kumar Mandal, Dean of Instructions, RIE, Mysuru briefed about the roles and functions of NCERT, RIEs and other constituent units of NCERT with explicit focus on RIE, Mysuru.

Prof. Pradyumna Kumar Sethy, Principal, RIEM, briefed about the roles and responsibilities of all the members of IQAC. Then Prof. I. P. Gowramma appraised the members of the work already undertaken by the IQAC. Further, she also, briefed the house about the forthcoming programmes in the current session, scheduled under IQAC. She emphasized the need to conduct meetings at regular intervals as per the schedule of all the members of IQAC.

The principal appraised the house that the institute is already undertaking capacity-building and training programmes for incorporating digital initiatives, maintaining a robust feedback mechanism, ensuring effective coordination & dissemination, and carrying out regular monitoring and auditing. He further informed that the institute is actively working towards developing a robust mechanism for documentation required for the NAAC Self-Appraisal Report, formulating need-based and data-driven work plans for quality enhancement, inviting alumni to participate in institutional programmes, and increasing the number of curricular and co-curricular activities—including interschool and intercollegiate competitions—to further enrich the vibrant atmosphere of the institute, to facilitate the holistic development of all the students.

Prof. Pratyusha Kumar Mandal apprised the house of the ongoing and proposed infrastructural initiatives, including the introduction of student-friendly furniture, modernization of laboratories and classroom spaces, and renovation of existing facilities in the institute. The Administrative Officer further highlighted major proposals submitted to headquarters, such as the construction of new boys' and girls' hostels, a G+4 administrative building, a campus ring road for enhanced security, and indoor sporting facilities. The Headmaster of the PM Shri Demonstration School additionally apprised the house about upcoming projects like new primary school

building, innovative measures for classroom capacity enhancement, and perimeter fencing to ensure improved safety for students.

Suggestions were then invited from the members regarding the future course of action for the IQAC. The following suggestions were received:

1. Being prepared for revisions in NAAC metrics & format and strategically working to improve performance across all indicators, ensuring that institutional data is systematically organized and appropriately presented for NAAC submissions.

3. Organising stress-management and mental health workshops for students.
4. Participating through online mode in the National Task Force mental health survey.
5. Ensuring adherence to all SOPs related to NAAC.
6. Maintaining Outcome Based Education (OBE) compliant syllabi.
7. Capacity building programme on strengthening fire-safety systems on campus.
8. Evolving clear institutional guidelines of proper documentation for NAAC.
9. Strengthening alumni networks and maintaining proper records
10. Focusing on research and institutional scholarship enhancement.

It was resolved that the above suggestions would be implemented after due consideration and systematic evaluation.


The meeting concluded with vote of thanks by Prof. Ram Babu Pareek, Co-convenor, IQAC.
