The Regional Institute of Education, Mysuru invites on-line applications for Admission into **4-Year Integrated B.Sc.B.Ed. & B.A.B.Ed.(Secondary Stage)** Programmes under ITEP for the Academic Session **2026-27**.

- **Only candidates having their Roll Numbers in the NCET-2026 Result List will be eligible to apply for admission.**
- The date of commencement for the submission of the application form begins at 12 noon **07.07.2026 (Tuesday)**.
- The deadline for submission of the On-line Application is midnight 12.00 noon **20.07.2026 (Monday)**.

B. Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Minimum Academic Standard:** Candidates must have secured at least **50% marks in aggregate** (or an equivalent Grade/CGPA) in their Grade XII (10+2 System) or equivalent qualifying examination.
- 2. Relaxation Provisions:** A relaxation of 5% in aggregate marks shall be granted to candidates belonging to SC, ST & PwD categories bringing their minimum required threshold to **45% marks**.
- 3. Year of Passing the Qualifying Examination:** To be eligible for admission into the 4-Year Integrated B.Sc.B.Ed. & B.A.B.Ed.(Secondary Stage) Programmes under ITEP for the Academic Session 2026-27, candidates must have successfully passed their Grade/Class XII Board or equivalent qualifying examination in the following years:
 - a. Year 2024** (Pass-out candidates)
 - b. Year 2025** (Pass-out candidates)
 - c. Year 2026** (pass-out candidates)
- 4. Status of Result:** Candidates, who have appeared for their Grade/Class XII Board Examinations or equivalent qualifying examination in 2026 and are still awaiting their final results, are provisionally eligible to apply for admissions provided they have appeared in the NCET-2026 and have obtained valid NTA Score. However, they must fulfill the minimum 50% (or 45% in case of SC, ST & PwD candidates) marks requirement in their Qualifying Examination by submitting their original Mark/Grade Sheets as proof of meeting the minimum academic standards for admissions at the time of counseling/final admission.
- 5. Subject Compatibility:** The candidates should have the following subject compatibility in addition to the criteria as mentioned above:

C. Guidelines for Reservation:

- Candidates, who seek admission under SC & ST category need to submit the requisite certificates issued by a competent authority as specified in **Annexure-2**.
- Candidates, who seek admission under the OBC (NCL) or EWS Category need to submit their OBC (NCL) & EWS Certificates issued by a competent authority as specified in Annexure 2 on or after April 1, 2026 and in 'forms' as given in **Annexure 3** for OBC (NCL) and **Annexure 4** for EWS categories. Candidates, having secured seats under OBC (NCL) & EWS categories shall be required to produce their valid certificates for verification at the time of joining the Institute.
- Candidates, who seek admission under the PwD category need to submit their Disability or Unique Disability Identification (UDID) certificates. Benefits of reservations under PwD category shall be given on the basis of benchmark disability (40% impairment irrespective of the type of disability). Such candidates must submit their Certificates of Disability from a Government Medical Board (preferably in the format given in the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017) along with the duly filled-in application forms certifying their fitness to pursue the intended Programme. If required, the disability percentage of candidates selected for admission under the PwD category may also be referred to a Medical Board duly constituted by the RIE, Mysuru for verification. - Candidates must note that the benefits of reservation shall be accorded subject to verification of documents. If it is discovered at any stage of the admission process that a candidate has used a false/fake/incorrect document or has furnished false/incorrect/ incomplete information in order to avail of the benefits of reservation, such a candidate shall be summarily excluded from the admission process. In case such a candidate has already taken admission, the same will be cancelled forthwith.
- The information and Proforma relevant to certificates for reserved categories are attached herewith as Annexures 2, 3 & 4 respectively.

D. Application Procedure:

1. Applications for admissions into the 4-Year Integrated B.Sc.B.Ed. & B.A.B.Ed.(Secondary Stage) Programmes of RIE, Mysuru under ITEP for the Academic Session 2026-27 **needs to be submitted on-line through the Link as given at the top** by paying a non-refundable application fee of ₹100/- based on the eligibility criteria as mentioned under Para-B (1-5) above.
2. No Off-line application shall be entertained.
3. **Requirement of Unique E-mail Ids for Multiple Applications:** If a candidate wishes to submit more than one on-line application, depending on whether the application is for the B.Sc.B.Ed. or B.A.B.Ed. Programme, s/he must use a different Unique e-mail ID for each such application.
4. At the time of admission, all selected candidates shall have to submit a Physical Fitness Certificate from a registered medical practitioner in the prescribed format as given in Annexure 5 to the RIE, Mysuru.

E. Rules for Admission:

The allocation of seats and the preparation of the merit lists for admission into the 4-Year Integrated B.Sc.B.Ed. & B.A.B.Ed.(Secondary Stage) Programmes for the academic session 2026-27 shall be governed strictly by the following rules, mapped in chronological order from the release of the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) scores to final campus registration:

1. **Course Options Based on NCET-2026 Test Papers:** A candidate can apply for one or more Major under the B.Sc.B.Ed. and B.A.B.Ed. Programmes provided they have qualified in the corresponding required domain-specific Test Papers in the NCET-2026 and meet the minimum eligibility criteria.
2. **Mandatory Order of Preference:** The Majors, which a candidate is interested in, must be selected and applied for in strict order of preference at the time of submission of application(s). No changes in the preferences shall be allowed after the submission(s) of the online application form(s) through the given Link.

F. Preparation of Merit List

1. The Merit Lists shall be prepared separately for each Major as per the given **Seat Matrix**.
2. These Lists shall be prepared taking into consideration the candidates' merit [based on the NTA-2026 score in Domain Subjects (1, 2 and 3), General Test, Teaching Aptitude, and Languages (1 and 2)], reservation criteria and State/UT-wise allocation of seats.
3. The NTA-2026 Score shall be considered up to 6 decimal points or as mentioned in the NTA-2026 Score Card of the candidate.
4. **Allotment of Seat in order of Preference:** Candidates can apply for any Major in order of preference (Preference 1, Preference 2, Preference 3, Preference 4) from the subjects as mentioned under Para C in Table-3 above.

5. **Allotment of Seat Against Preference-1:** If a candidate is allotted a seat against Preference 1, such an allotment shall be treated as final. Therefore, the candidate shall not be considered for any other Major in any subsequent round of counselling.
6. **Consideration of Preference 2, Preference 3, and Preference 4:** In case a candidate is not allotted a seat against Preference 1, the same candidate shall be considered for allotment of seat against Preference 2. If the candidate fails to get a seat against Preference 2, allotment of seat against Preference 3 shall be considered. If the candidate still does not get a seat against Preference 3, allotment of seat against Preference 4 shall be considered. All these Preferences shall be taken into consideration only against available seats.
7. **Provision for Revision of Preference:** A candidate with a seat allotted against Preference 2, Preference 3 or Preference 4 in the first round of counselling, could be considered for revision of preference in the subsequent round(s), if seats are available.
8. **Process of Counselling:** Counselling for admission shall continue in successive rounds until all seats are filled as per the Seat Matrix.

Example:

Suppose a candidate has given the following preferences:

Preference 1: Botany

Preference 2: Zoology

Preference 3: Chemistry

Preference 4: Mathematics

Going by Preference, if a candidate is allotted Botany in the First Round of Counselling, the allotment shall be treated as final. The same candidate shall not be permitted to participate in subsequent rounds of counselling;

If a candidate is allotted Zoology in the First Round of Counselling, in that case Revision of Preference to Botany shall be considered for that candidate in the Second Round of Counselling if any seat is still available for admission based on criteria as mentioned against Clause 2 above.

The process of Revision of Preference shall be applicable in each successive Round of Counselling accordingly.

G. Key Principle of Counselling:

The counselling system shall be transparent, merit-based, reservation-compliant, and preference-driven, ensuring fair and orderly allotment of seats until the entire admission process is complete.

H. State/UT Domicile Status

1. The RIE, Mysuru caters to the southern region of the country. Therefore, the candidates having domicile status in the States of **Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telangana** and the Union Territories of **Puducherry and Lakshadweep** shall only be considered for admission.

2. **Domicile Criteria:** Candidates are required to select the appropriate State/UT against which they are seeking admission. As proof of their domicile status, they have to produce any one of the following documents:
 - a) Evidence of having passed the qualifying examination (Grade 12 Board) from the States of **Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telangana** and the Union Territories of **Puducherry and Lakshadweep** (e.g., certificate of qualifying examination);
 - b) Evidence of any one of the parents/legal guardians working in the States of **Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telangana** and the Union Territories of **Puducherry and Lakshadweep** as an employee under the Central Government/Government of India Undertaking/Autonomous Body/State Government/State Government Undertaking/Autonomous Body (e.g., certificate of place of posting);
 - c) Evidence of domicile with reference to nativity/residence in the States of **Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telangana** and the Union Territories of **Puducherry and Lakshadweep** (e.g., certificate issued by a competent authority).

I. State-Wise Quota Allocation:

1. Candidates shall be ranked and provisionally selected as per their **Merit, Preference of Major** and **reservation category** based on their NTA-2026 score in descending order within their respective State/UT quota.
2. In the event of two or more candidates securing equal NTA-2026 score within a specific State quota or reservation category, selections shall be made on the basis of following principles:
 - a) Preference shall be given first to the candidate with higher NTA-2026 score in the specific domain subject as per preferred Major -1 (e.g., if the tie is for a seat in Physics major, the NTA-2026 score in Physics score shall be considered first).
 - b) If NTA-2026 domain subject scores are also equal, the NTA-2026 score in Teaching Aptitude shall be considered for selection.
 - c) If a tie still persists, the aggregate marks in Grade 12 Board examination shall be taken into consideration for selection.

J. Allocation of Seats under Reserved Categories:

Reservation of seats shall be made based on the Government of India norms as shown below after taking into consideration the prepared State/UT wise merit lists under each Major:

- a) Scheduled Castes (SC): 15%
- b) Scheduled Tribes (ST): 7.5%
- c) Other Backward Classes (OBC-NCL): 27%
- d) Economically Weaker Sections (EWS): 10%
- e) Persons with Disabilities (PwD): 5% Horizontal reservation as per regulations

K. Counselling and Admission

1. Based on the prepared **Merit Lists** provisionally selected candidates shall be called for on-line counseling for admission. The dates for online counselling shall be notified in the Institute website (www.riemysore.ac.in) and also intimated to the selected candidates individually through e-mail in their given e-mail ids.
2. Following on-line counselling, the provisionally selected candidates shall be invited for taking admission in their respective Programmes at the Regional Institute of Education (NCERT), Manasagangotri, Mysuru-570006, Karnataka. The dates for admissions into different Programmes shall be notified on the Institute website (www.riemysore.ac.in) and also intimated to the selected candidates individually through e-mail in their given e-mail ids.
3. The candidates shall be required to physically produce all original documents including the NTA-2026 Score Card, Grade 10 Marksheet, Grade 12 Board Marksheet, Domicile Certificate and Reservation Certificate as required.
4. All admissions shall be deemed provisional, and if any discrepancy is found at the time of admission between the uploaded documents and the physical produced original documents, the admission shall be cancelled.

L. Important Instructions:

- Applicants are requested to periodically check the RIE, Mysuru website (www.riemysore.ac.in) for updated information with regard to the admission process. They should also regularly check their registered E-mail IDs for any message with regard to the admission process.
- Incomplete application or applications without submission of corresponding valid documents shall be summarily rejected.
- The Application Form for admission shall not be considered without payment of the application fee.
- The application fee, once paid, shall not be refunded under any condition.
- No intimation shall be sent to the candidate if her/his application/s is/are rejected.
- Following selection and allocation of a seat, if a candidate fails to take admission within the stipulated time, the seat shall be deemed as forfeited.
- Once a candidate fails to take admission against the allotted seat in a preferred Major, the candidate shall not be considered for admission in that Major at any subsequent stage of the admission process. However, the candidate shall be eligible to take admission in her/his 2nd or 3rd preferred Major provided s/he qualifies for such admission(s).
- The candidates should note that being on the Provisional Selection List neither guarantees nor provides them an automatic entitlement for admission. All admissions shall be made strictly based on merit, which shall be prepared taking all concerned criteria into consideration.

- All offers of admission shall be deemed provisional until all requirements are fulfilled by the candidates as stipulated by the Institute.
- With regard to the interpretation of the provisions on any matter not covered in these guidelines, the decision of the RIE, Mysuru shall be considered final and binding.
- Candidates are advised to visit the Institute website and check their e-mail Ids regularly for notification(s) with regard to any change in the **Seat Matrix** or **rules** concerning the admission process.
- The Institute will not entertain any claim or dispute with regard to the NCET-2026 or the NTA-2026 Score. Any such claim or dispute must be settled with the NTA.
- All legal matters concerning the admission process will be subject to the territorial jurisdiction of Mysuru.

To ensure each subject receives exactly **20 seats** while perfectly honoring the state ratios, the 100 core seats are distributed symmetrically. Majors related to the old PCM stream (Mathematics, Physics) and CBZ stream (Botany, Zoology) inherit their corresponding state counts, while Chemistry (which bridges both) is evenly balanced.
