

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs): ITEP Admission 2026–27

Regional Institute of Education (NCERT), Mysuru

1. Who is eligible to apply for ITEP admission at RIE Mysuru?

Candidates who have (a) appeared in NCET-2026 conducted by NTA, (b) satisfy the eligibility criteria as prescribed in the admission guidelines, and (c) belong to the eligible State/UTs for the chosen programme, may apply.

2. How will the merit list be prepared?

Please refer the Admission Guideline (Page NO. 4). The merit list shall be prepared based on:

- NTA-2026 score in the relevant Domain Subjects (1, 2 and 3)
- General Test,
- Teaching Aptitude
- Languages (1 and 2)

3. Is filling the Google Form mandatory?

Every eligible candidate must apply in the prescribed Google Form within the stipulated time. No application shall be entertained off-line.

4. I did not choose Hindi as Language 2 (L2) in NCET What should I do?

Candidates, who did not opt for **Hindi as Language 2 (L2)**, need to mention the Language 2 (L2) in which they appeared in the NCET. This information is required for preparing the merit list and verifying language eligibility. If Hindi was not your Language 2, you must specify your actual L2 (such as Kannada, Malayalam, Tamil, Telugu, Bengali, etc.) in the Google Form.

5. Can I edit my Google Form after submission?

Candidates should carefully verify all information before submitting the Form. No change is allowed after submission of the Form.

6. How will counselling be conducted?

Counselling will be conducted online or as notified by RIE Mysuru. Candidates should regularly check the official website: www.riemysore.ac.in and their registered email/mobile for updates.

7. What happens if two candidates obtain the same merit score?

In such a scenario, appropriate decision shall be taken by the Admission Committee based on provisions as specified in the admission guidelines.

8. In NCET, I had the option to choose only three Domain Subjects. However, the Google Form shows Preference 4 as a mandatory field. What should I do?

Candidates, who appeared for only three Domain Subjects in NCET-2026, may repeat their 1st Preferences as a Preference 4.

9. I am applying under the Andhra Pradesh (or another State/UT) quota but do not have a Tahsildar-issued Domicile Certificate. I have continuous School Study Certificates from Classes IV to XII. Can I upload these instead?

If you do not currently possess a Tahsildar-issued Domicile/Residence Certificate, you may upload your continuous School Study Certificates (Classes IV to XII) as supporting proof of your Domicile status to meet the State/UT eligibility criterion. In this regard, please refer the Admission Guideline (Page No. 5).

10. Where can I find official notifications and updates?

All admission-related notification/ announcements will be uploaded on the official RIE Mysuru website: www.riemysore.ac.in. Candidates are advised to visit the website regularly and not rely on unofficial sources.
